 - MEANS is an international, non-profit, all-volunteer Christian organization based in Illinois, USA, dedicated to sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ and helping the needy by partnering with churches, mission groups, foreign and national missionaries in East Asia and East Asians worldwide.
